After an extensive search that stretched over several years, the Board of Trustees has approved Workday as the College's new Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) System.

Currently, the College uses Banner as the ERP software solution to manage data, including the Student, Finance, and Human Resources operations. Since the implementation of Banner, new cloud-based systems have been developed that offer improved technological features and capabilities. In order to streamline and enhance internal data management, College Administrators and staff, led by Mary Elizondo, Vice President for Finance and Administrative Services, Stefan Stoyanof, Human Resources Information Services Officer, and Victoria Lopez, FAS Project Manager performed extensive research on ERP systems used by peer higher education institutions and coordinated demonstrations from multiple vendors on the functionalities of their ERP systems.
